GIVE ONLINE

Whether you'd like to give a single gift, schedule ongoing donations, or view & print your giving history, you can do it all online. You can securely give by using your checking account, debit card, or credit card (that you pay off each month!).

DURING A SERVICE

Cash or check can be given during any of our Sunday services. If you'd like to receive a tax deduction for cash gifts, the gift should be placed in an offering envelope with your name and address on it. Offering envelopes are available at all of our congregations.
