

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES



1. Scholarships are available to Bethel Brentwood church members during the run of any stewardship classes such as *I Was Broke. Now I'm Not.* or *Financial Peace University (FPU)*.
2. Applicants are encouraged to apply before classes begin.
3. Applicants must apply for scholarship by submitting one to two paragraphs describing a genuine need for a scholarship and how they hope to pay this forward. Please email your submission to Drew Powell at momentum@bethelworld.org.
4. Two scholarships will be awarded during the run of any class/session.
5. We encourage church members to contribute towards our scholarship fund by going to Bethel's giving site, selecting "Designated" as the fund and typing in "Momentum."
6. Momentum offers 25%, 50% and, in some cases, 100% funding to attend classes. 100% funding may be provided on a reimbursement basis at the end of each course.
7. Upon graduation, recipients must be willing to write one to two paragraphs expounding on what they have learned from the class as a testimony to encourage future participants.
8. Applicants must be willing to attend all classes, or scholarships may become null and void, and full payment of classes invoiced to the applicant.
9. Applicants will be asked to give the name, telephone number and email of a relative or friend who they believe will benefit from the program after graduation. If the class has helped an attendee, we encourage attendees to promote the classes.
10. Applicants must be willing to arrange a 15-minute exit interview with a Momentum Stewardship Ministry team member or leader.
